The Tribunal encloses its decision in respect of your client's appeal against the decline of an application for residence by Immigration New Zealand (INZ).

The Tribunal found that the decision of INZ was based on an incorrect assessment in terms of the Government residence policy applicable at the time your client's application was lodged. However, it was not satisfied that the terms of that policy were met.

Pursuant to section 18D(1)(e) of the Immigration Act 1987, the Tribunal has cancelled the decision and referred the application back to the Secretary of Labour for a correct assessment in terms of the applicable Government residence policy. Please note INZ is a division of the Department of Labour and will carry out another assessment of the application on behalf of the Secretary of Labour.

Your client should now contact the nearest branch of INZ to arrange for the application to be reassessed. Your client should allow time for the INZ files to be returned by the Tribunal to the branch.
